Public Works will accept hazardous waste on July 24 and July 25 ONLY **DO NOT LEAVE ITEMS AT THE SITE DURING OFF-HOURS**

DO NOT REMOVE LABELS

- Identify the contents of all containers if they are not already labeled.
- A 220-pound waste limit for each household and business is in effect. Businesses with more than 220 pounds should contact Jolene Cox at 907-586-4447 or jcox@coxenv.com prior to the event to determine eligibility and disposal charges.
- All waste must be brought to the collection site unless arrangements have been made for the Public Works to pick up the waste. This will be a limited service provided to the elderly or to people otherwise incapable of delivering the waste.
- The Municipality accepts batteries during the event. Auto batteries will be accepted in any condition; they do not need to be drained. Non-rechargeable alkaline batteries are not considered hazardous and can be safely disposed of in the household trash; button batteries and rechargeable batteries containing heavy metals are hazardous and will be accepted at the collection event.
- Containers will be returned to individuals upon request.
- Avoid bringing children or pets to the collection event.
- Cardboard boxes and plastic bags used to transport the waste will be accepted for disposal.
